As we prepare to return to school, we are pleased to announce that Capital Diagnostics Laboratory will come to our campus for onsite drive through COVID-19 testing of all faculty, staff, current coaches and students on Tuesday, October 6 and Friday, October 9. This will give us a baseline and will allow those who test positive to isolate at home before coming to campus. The anterior nasal swab PCR test will be required for everyone returning to campus.

The report will be sent directly to your email address. In addition, Holy Cross will have access to the results. If you prefer to go to your own provider for the COVID-19 test <u>please notify Kathleen Clark, RN, School Nurse</u>, make sure you get a PCR test completed between October 6 and October 9, and send the results before returning to school.

The assay used is called PerkinElmer, which is the most sensitive molecular test.
